Professor Joe Schatzker – CM, MD, BSc (Med) , FRCSC is the father of tibial plateau surgery . His pioneering work on the management of these fractures revolutionized the outcome for patients. For 50 years he has been in the forefront of advances in trauma surgery and continues to work as a consultant at the Sunnybrook Medical Center in Toronto.

Professor Harm Hoekstra MD currently works in Leuven , Belgium. For the past 10 years he has been a leading researcher in the field of traumatology with a specialist interest in tibial plateau fractures. His work on surgical approaches and the development of new implants suitable for stabilization of posterior fractures has led to a greater understanding of these injuries and how they should be treated optimally.
